THE WISDOM OF GANDHI A message from our Ministerial Team

Beginning the first Sunday in October, we will offer a sevenweek series on applying the wisdom of Mahatma Gandhi in our individual lives. As Gandhi himself said: "I have not the shadow of a doubt that any man or woman can achieve what I have, if he or she would make the same effort and cultivate the same hope and faith."

Each week, our Sunday message will explore one of Gandhi's teachings. Weekly study questions will be printed in the Sunday program, which will include a weekly affirmation card. We encourage you to use these affirmations as part of your personal prayer and meditation time. Notice how the power of your commitment increases as you add cards each week. We also highly recommend the book, *Gandhi the Man: How one man changed himself to change the world*, by Eknath Easwaran. Copies of the book will be available in our bookstore.

Albert Einstein honored Gandhi in the following words: "A leader of his people, unsupported by any outward authority: a politician whose success rests not upon craft nor the mastery of technical devices, but simply on the convincing power of his personality; a victorious fighter who has always scorned the use of force; a man of wisdom and humility, armed with resolve and inflexible consistency, who has devoted all his strength to the uplifting of his people and the betterment of their lot; a man who has confronted the brutality of Europe with the dignity of the simple human being, and thus at all times risen superior. Generations to come, it may be, will scarce believe that such a one as this ever in flesh and blood walked upon this earth."

We are blessed to have Gandhi's example on our journey of awakening to the wisdom of Spirit within us.

A Note about Unity's Sacred Women's Circle by Géna Duel



In February 2024, I felt a nudge from Spirit to offer a Sacred Women's Circle at Unity. I shared the ideas flowing through me with our Ministerial Team, and they were on board. In April 2024 our first Sacred Women's Circle took place.

At that first gathering in April 2024, we had 17 women show up. I was blown away at the sharing and the depth of wisdom sitting in the room. The overall energy in the room was one of excitement and a readiness to connect and hold space for each other. It became very clear to me in that moment why Spirit was nudging me.

Each month we have a different theme that we focus on. We spend time meditating, connecting, and then we have a project that incorporates that month's theme. From the very beginning I shared with the group that I envisioned different women leading the group each month so that we all have the opportunity to share our gifts, wisdom, and play. And while we haven't yet achieved the goal of a different woman leading the group each month, more and more are stepping up to do it or to co-lead. It's beautiful to watch the creativity flowing through each of us.

We've made a talking stick and an altar cloth for our gatherings that incorporates each woman's energy, intention, love, and wisdom. The depth of Spirit expressed is awesome. We've explored Walking with Our Ancestors, Sacred Life, Sacred Water, Gifts of Nature, Sacred Sound Healing, Life Collaging, and so much more. I feel so blessed to be a part of such a beautiful community of strong, wise, vulnerable, spiritual women, and we are growing each month.





Grants typically range from \$50 to \$500 for short-term (not ongoing) financial needs, depending on the need and availability of funds.

WAYS YOU CAN CONTRIBUTE FINANCIALLY

- Send a check to Unity of the Valley, 3912 Dillard Rd., Eugene, OR 97405 with a note designating if it's for the CSF or general Unity finances.
- Make a donation through PayPal using the yellow DONATE button on the home page of our website: unityofthevalley.org.
 This can be a one-time donation, repeated as often as you wish for different amounts, or a monthly recurring donation for a set amount. Be sure you designate your donation to be applied to CSF or to general Unity finances.
- Send an email to unityval@riousa.com stating that you wish to pledge a certain amount to the CSF or to general Unity finances. Give your phone number so Géna can contact you to arrange how and when you wish to donate.
- Write a letter stating you wish to join our Simple Giving Fund to contribute a set amount (state the amount) on a regular basis (state how often) with your bank account routing and account number. Just designate what portion should be used for the CSF or general Unity finances. Géna, our Office Administrator, opens all our mail in private. So, it is safe to include your account information in a letter, but not in an email.

To request monetary help, you can write a letter or an email (<u>unityval@riousa.com</u>) directed to the Ministerial Team. Please include the following information:

- 1. Your name, mailing address, phone number, and email address.
- 2. Your association with Unity of the Valley.
- 3. Name of a reference at Unity of the Valley (someone who knows you).
- 4. Brief description of your financial need.
- 5. How much you are requesting.
- 6. Do you think your financial needs will require monthly support?
 Requests for monetary help will be reviewed by our Ministerial
 Team. If a request is approved, the amount granted will be
 dependent on how many requests we receive and how much money
 is available in the CSF.
