the outer world, inner freedom is possible. We see this truth demonstrated in the consciousness of our greatest leaders for social justice:

- Henry David Thoreau, after being imprisoned for protesting slavery, wrote: I saw that, if there was a wall of stone between me and my townsmen, there was a still more difficult one to break through before they could get to be as free as I was.
- Nelson Mandela expressed his inner freedom after 21
  years in prison this way: As I walked out the door toward
  the gate that would lead to my freedom, I knew if I didn't
  leave my bitterness and hatred behind, I'd still be in
  prison.
- Aung San Suu Kyi, the Nobel Peace Prizewinner who spent 15 of 21 years under house arrest in Burma, wrote: Whenever I was asked at the end of each stretch of house arrest how it felt to be free, I would answer that I felt no different because my mind had always been free. I have spoken out, often, of the inner freedom that comes out from following a course in harmony with one's conscience.

The message is clear: Releasing the mental/emotional chains that trap and drain our life force is essential to fulfilled living. Throughout April, we invite you to stride forward with us into this great frontier of higher consciousness and undreamed-of possibilities.

### **Youth & Family Ministry News**

The Galileans, our youth class for children in grades 3 to 5, have been having adventures down the rabbit hole this year! Our fun has included service projects, fundraising, and lessons on Unity principles – all while joining Alice in her adventures through Wonderland with the help of the Unity Association of Churches' curriculum, *The Metaphysics of Wonderland*. The youth teachers have enjoyed creating additional lessons to enhance our learning and fun.

We started the year painting rocks, which we placed in the meditation garden, Unity of the Valley's own "Wonderland." We have learned about transformation from the caterpillar, and made beautiful butterfly prints; we learned about divine guidance from the Cheshire cat, and played pin-the-grin-on-the-cat; and we learned about living in "the now" from the Mad Hatter. Of course, any study of Alice in Wonderland needs to include a Mad Hatter's tea party, so, we enjoyed mid-morning tea, complete with a golden teapot and biscuits! Recently, we played croquet and talked about "keeping our heads" even in the midst of challenges like dealing with the Queen of Hearts.



Throughout the year, we make crafts to sell at our fundraisers, which fund our service projects. In December, we had our Christmas bazaar and raised money to buy 75 red roses, which we delivered –along with handmade Valentines– to the residents of Good Samaritan nursing home in February. Afterwards, the children shared that this activity made them feel generous and kind. One child said they "had made a grandma very

happy" that day. It is a beautiful sight to see elders take such pleasure in the children, and vice versa.

On April 26, we will hold our annual plant sale, and we welcome donations of plants and starts. Our proceeds will go to First Place Family Center to be used for supplies for the children they serve.

We appreciate your generosity in helping us realize our vision in providing meaningful experiences for our children.


