# YOUTH & FAMILY MINISTRY (YFM)

A vital key to transforming our world is giving young people practical spiritual tools for living and opportunities to express their innate joy, love, mutual respect, and creative potential. YFM provides all of this every Sunday in a safe, fun, and nurturing environment for five different age groups:

- 1. Unitots provides childcare with learning opportunities for infants and children up to age 3 or 4i
- 2. Unikids is the next step up, with children generally in Grades K-2;
- 3. Galileans is for Grades 3-5;
- 4. Uniteens is for Grades 6-8;
- 5. Y.O.U. (Youth of Unity) is for teenagers Grades 9-12.

Through activities that engage both the heart and mind—such as music, stories, drama, arts & crafts, meditation, and community service—participants learn life values that can last a lifetime. These values are reinforced through positive interaction with our adult membership and through retreats, camps, and other special events in the larger community.

### Youth & Family Ministry

Ever since I can remember – before going to ministerial school, while I was in ministerial school, and at this point in time – our Youth Ministry Program has served Unity of the Valley's children and families as one of the strongest and most consistent ministries in our church. It continues to be that today.

Our Youth and Family Ministry Program began in a little room off what is now the fellowship area, with a nursery half the size of the Harmony Room; and it continues its ministry of education, inspiration, compassion, guidance and love in the Fillmore Wing, built for the purpose of housing this program. Even with the absence of the magnificently dedicated Mary Criggs, some of the same people have served this ministry consistently into its third decade and, while we are all growing older together, the integrity, the passion, and the commitment to the teaching of truth principles to our children has not lagged for a moment.

Yes, we have had varying levels of attendance – from 8 children to 65 to 25 or 30 – but the adult church ministry has experienced its ups and down numerically as well. Youth Ed has, however, continued to be financially solvent, thanks to gifts from the general fund and gifts from individual and consistent fundraisers. It has contributed to the community outside the church in many ways, with backpacks for school kids, flowers to Good Samaritan Center, food and supplies and monetary gifts to First Place Family Shelter, and teddy bears to Bags of Love, to mention just a few. Not a year has gone by without these gifts continuing to be offered, at least as far back as I can remember (and I began my tenure here in the late 80s). Youth Ed has also seen to it that our kids can go to regional events if they so desire – and there are other things to be proud of as well.

God's grace has abundantly blessed this program through our Youth Ed staff's efforts and through you, our congregation. I want to take this opportunity to say how proud I am of each and every person who has given time and energy to this vital ministry and to what we offer for our youth. It seems the right and perfect things to do as we go through the summer with a bit of a lighter program while preparing for the coming school year. Please continue to hold us in your hearts, support us with you gifts of love, and be ready to hear from us again and again, for our voice is your voice echoing back to you as a reminder of the ongoingness of life.

## **Elder Council Ministry**

The Elder Council is a group of elders, 60 years old and over, who meet weekly to share their wisdom, experience, energy, and authenticity. Together, they explore the art of growing older gracefully through discussion of the book *The Cift of Years, Crowing Older Cracefully*, by Joan Chittister. Topics such as "Letting Cyo," "Fear," "Possibility," "Bucket Lists" and "Paying it Forward" are discussed. The Council sponsored the Death Cafe and the panel discussion on Personalizing End-of-Life Choices in an effort to normalize discussions of death, and to provide information about end-of-life choices and resources.

The Elder Council is a service-oriented organization as well. Among other projects discussed, they recently took over the coordination of the Angel Network and plan to expand its outreach. They also wrote a letter to the Editor of the Register Guard acknowledging two young girls who took a stand on a political issue important to them.




# What's Going on in Israel, and Why? Wednesdays, 10:00-11:15 am Starts September 10
