CREATING RELATIONSHIPS AS REFUGE: How to "Re-pair"

Tuesdays, May 5-June 9 7:00-8:30 p.m.

Everyone gets hooked or triggered emotionally at times. We get into reactivity, we start running our familiar "stories" and limiting beliefs, and our relatedness to those we care about breaks down. Join Karen Love Baisinger in this 6-week group process on how to "re-pair" in your relationship quickly when either of you loses touch with emotional safety and connection. Learn new skills and shift your energy as a couple, or as an individual seeking to grow more skillful in your relationship, or as someone taking a break from relationships to transform how they show up for you, or as one who simply wants to improve the quality of all your relationships. It is important for the kids to understand the amount of effort it takes to put these events together so they can attend. I'm excited about our upcoming carwash and other new volunteer opportunities. We check in every week to see how they are doing and explore their "low points", followed by discussion of how to better approach a challenging situation the next time one comes up.

Working with Sherry has been an absolute joy. I hope that the rest of the church knows how much she commits to the children and her support has been invaluable. Unity has become home to my children and me, and we feel so lucky to be part of it all with you.

Youth & Family Ministry News



Did you know that the Youth & Family Ministry supports a child in Honduras by monthly giving and letter writing? We have sponsored Keidy Alejandra Pineda Argueta since she was 3 years old. She turned 10 years old on January 30. She is 4 feet tall and weighs about 53 pounds. She attends school, and her favorite subject is grammar. She loves to spend her free time

playing with dolls, jumping rope, and playing other games. She says her hobbies are drawing, painting, and singing.

Keidy lives with her parents. Her father is a bricklayer, and her mother is a factory worker. Household income varies depending on the availability of work. The average income is about \$350 a month. Keidy and her family live in a house constructed of concrete blocks, concrete flooring, and a corrugated metal roof. It has one bedroom and one multipurpose room. Keidy sleeps on a bed. Cooking is done on an electric burner. While dangerous, families can tap into electrical lines to light their homes. The sanitary facility is a toilet. They are fortunate to have running water.

Fortunately, our sponsorship is easing the burden for Keidy and her family. We help provide new clothing, sturdy shoes, access to basic health care, and medicine. We also help with school supplies and send special monetary gifts at holidays, birthdays, and sometimes just for a special hug of remembrance. We also write letters to her.

We have been her sponsor for seven years now and have received photos and thank you notes from her regularly. These can be seen on the bulletin board in the downstairs Garden room in the Fillmore Wing. We bring love offerings for her support and put them in a Prosperity Bank on our altar. Then it is collected, deposited into the church youth education account, and a monthly check is sent to her sponsoring agency. We enjoy helping out a lot.


Taizé Service Wednesday, May 6 7:00 p.m.
