LISTEN TO THE SEASON

What message does autumn have for us? How does nature's transition from hot to cool, from green to gold, from hard ground to soft soil, reflect in our own lives?



As we began our 7-week series on *Way of the Mystics*, we encountered the Buddhist idea of *shenpa* – mental hooks of attachment that cause us to constantly react against outer conditions. Learning to release these hooks undoubtedly helps us "cool down" and avoid getting steamed up over little stuff. In week two, we pondered how easily we can lose track of being fully in the Now. Serenely enjoying the wonder of each moment is another way to lower the temperature in our overheated mind-body systems.

Our series took a new turn in week three. That's when the combined wisdom of 1,500 years of life experience was shared by Unity's Elder Council. Through them, as well as through Father Bede Criffiths in week four, we felt the beauty and triumph of the human heart transitioning from green to golden – from the confusion of youth to the dawning of spiritual awareness.

In November, the *Way of the Mystics* will turn again, carrying with it all the gifts of the previous weeks. Walking with the Hindu poet Mirabai, Sufi master Hazrat Inayat Khan, and Christian mystic Hildegard of Bingen, we will step off the hard pavement of modern life into the timeless field of being – the field where all the rains of human desire, and all the rivers of knowledge and religion, converge. The field of unconditional wholeness and love that's always been within us.

These values are reinforced through positive interaction with our adult membership and through retreats, camps, and other special events in the larger community.
