BLESSED ARE THE PURE IN HEART

A message from our Ministerial Team

This month, we will step into the garden of wisdom shared by Jesus in his Sermon on the Mount, specifically his sixth Beatitude: “Blessed are the pure in heart for they shall see God” (Matthew 5:8). Unity co-founder Charles Fillmore wrote about this verse in his book, *The Revealing Word*: “The deep purity and mighty strength of the Christ Mind are made manifest in those who develop spiritually.”

Regarding this same verse, the Indian master Paramahansa Yogananda wrote, “Reality cannot be accurately reflected in a consciousness ruffled by likes and dislikes, with their restless passions and desires, and the roiling emotions they engender—anger, jealousy, greed, moody sensitivity. But when human knowing and feeling are calmed by meditation, the ordinarily agitated ego gives way to the blessed calmness of soul perception.”

In Unity, the true “heart” of us is understood as our Divine essence or spark, not the central muscle that circulates our blood, though the physical heart is a powerful expression of that spark. Nor are we the onion-like layers of habitual thought and feelings that have gelled into our personalities. Beneath the tangled vines of our human identity is an unchanging ground—what we in Unity sometimes call “the I Am presence.”

The I Am presence not only contains our own deepest being, it is the ground of all being. If that sounds like a paradox and a mystery to our intellectual mind, let it be so. Ultimate truths cannot be grasped by the workings of the mind alone. They must emerge in our awareness like a flower—the flower of realization from the pure seed of Spirit within. Throughout this month and beyond, we will be nurturing this realization as a spiritual community. Please join us!



SERVICES IN FEBRUARY

Sunday, February 1: “What If My Authentic Self is Nosy, Needy, and/or Not Nice?” with **Jon West**. The idea of “being ourselves” and “following one's heart” rather than conforming to cultural ideals has grown in popularity since at least the 1600s. But in a world (and mind) crowded with competing messages about who we are and what we need to be happy, we may hardly know our “true self” at all!

Sunday, February 8: “Closer to God is the One Who's in Love” with guest speaker **Weston Hudson** (see bio on page 4). Weston will explore how releasing rigid self-definitions allows us to return to a deeper experience of God — one rooted not in separation, but in love, presence, and unity.

Sunday, February 15: “Gathered in Love: A Unity Taizé Experience” led by **Laura DuBois**. This service will feature meditative chants, inspirational readings, prayers, and times of silence bringing participants to a deep spiritual connection and sense of peace. As the service unfolds, healing touch and prayers will be offered by a team of chaplains in the front of the sanctuary.

Sunday, February 22: “Walking the Path of Wholeness” with **Rev. Sherry Lady**. The twists, turns, and surprises of letting love be the guide on our journey to who we are really meant to be.

Weston Hudson has immersed himself in spiritual study, service, and training—most notably as a longtime attendee and student at Agape Spiritual Center, where he studied with Michael Beckwith and counseled with his brother Akili Beckwith. Outside of Agape, his path also included working with shamans, healers, mystics, and teachers across many traditions, exploring emotional healing, embodiment, forgiveness, prosperity consciousness, and presence.

Weston brought this inner work into the world in practical ways—teaching, coaching, and creating. Over the years, he has helped dozens of individuals move through emotional pain and confusion and reconnect with clarity, inspiration, and inner truth. He is also the creator of Sonic Prayers, a practice blending music, meditation, and affirmative prayer and an online course “Shift & Shine” where he helps individuals move through blocks to arrive at their deepest heart inspired visions and desires.



COMMUNITY SUPPORT FUND

Grants typically range from \$50 to \$500 for short-term (not ongoing) financial needs, depending on the need and availability of funds.

WAYS YOU CAN CONTRIBUTE FINANCIALLY

- **Send a check** to Unity of the Valley, 3912 Dillard Rd., Eugene, OR 97405 with a note designating if it's for the CSF or general Unity finances.
- **Make a donation through PayPal** using the yellow DONATE button on the home page of our website: unityofthevalley.org. This can be a one-time donation, repeated as often as you wish for different amounts, or a monthly recurring donation for a set amount. Be sure you designate your donation to be applied to CSF or to general Unity finances.
- **Send an email to unityval@riousa.com** stating that you wish to pledge a certain amount to the CSF or to general Unity finances. Give your phone number so Géna can contact you to arrange how and when you wish to donate.
- **Write a letter** stating you wish to join our ***Simple Giving Fund*** to contribute a set amount (state the amount) on a regular basis (state how often) with your bank account routing and account number. Just designate what portion should be used for the CSF or general Unity finances. Géna, our Office Administrator, opens all our mail in private. So, it is safe to include your account information in a letter, but not in an email.

IF YOU NEED MONETARY ASSISTANCE

To request monetary help, you can write a letter or an email (unityval@riousa.com) directed to the Ministerial Team. Please include the following information:

1. Your name, mailing address, phone number, and email address.
2. Your association with Unity of the Valley.
3. Name of a reference at Unity of the Valley (someone who knows you).
4. Brief description of your financial need.
5. How much you are requesting.
6. Do you think your financial needs will require monthly support?

Requests for monetary help will be reviewed by our Ministerial Team. If a request is approved, the amount granted will be dependent on how many requests we receive and how much money is available in the CSF.
